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RTI & Behavior: How to Set Up a School-Wide Positive Behavior Management Model

Schools with a strong RTI behavior model have well-managed classrooms throughout the building (Tier 1), supplemental group and individual interventions for more challenging behaviors (Tier 2), and the capacity to create customized behavior-treatment plans for students who display intensive, chronic behaviors (Tier 3). This workshop provides direction for any school on how to expand their existing RTI model to address behavior problems.

Participants will learn how to:

- screen the school-wide population to discover students who need intervention at Tiers 1, 2, & 3.
- promote effective core behavior-management practices in all classrooms.
- give teachers a toolkit to provide Tier 1 classroom behavioral interventions for selected students.
- measure student behaviors conveniently and quickly using free online tools: Behavior Report Cards & Behavior Checklists.
- select appropriate social/emotional/behavioral interventions for supplemental (Tier 2) interventions.
- expand the Tier 3 RTI Problem-Solving Team to allow it to develop customized behavioral intervention plans.

As a key feature of this workshop, participants will receive an 'RTI Behavior: Quality Indicators Checklist' to allow them to rate the effectiveness of their current RTI behavioral model.
